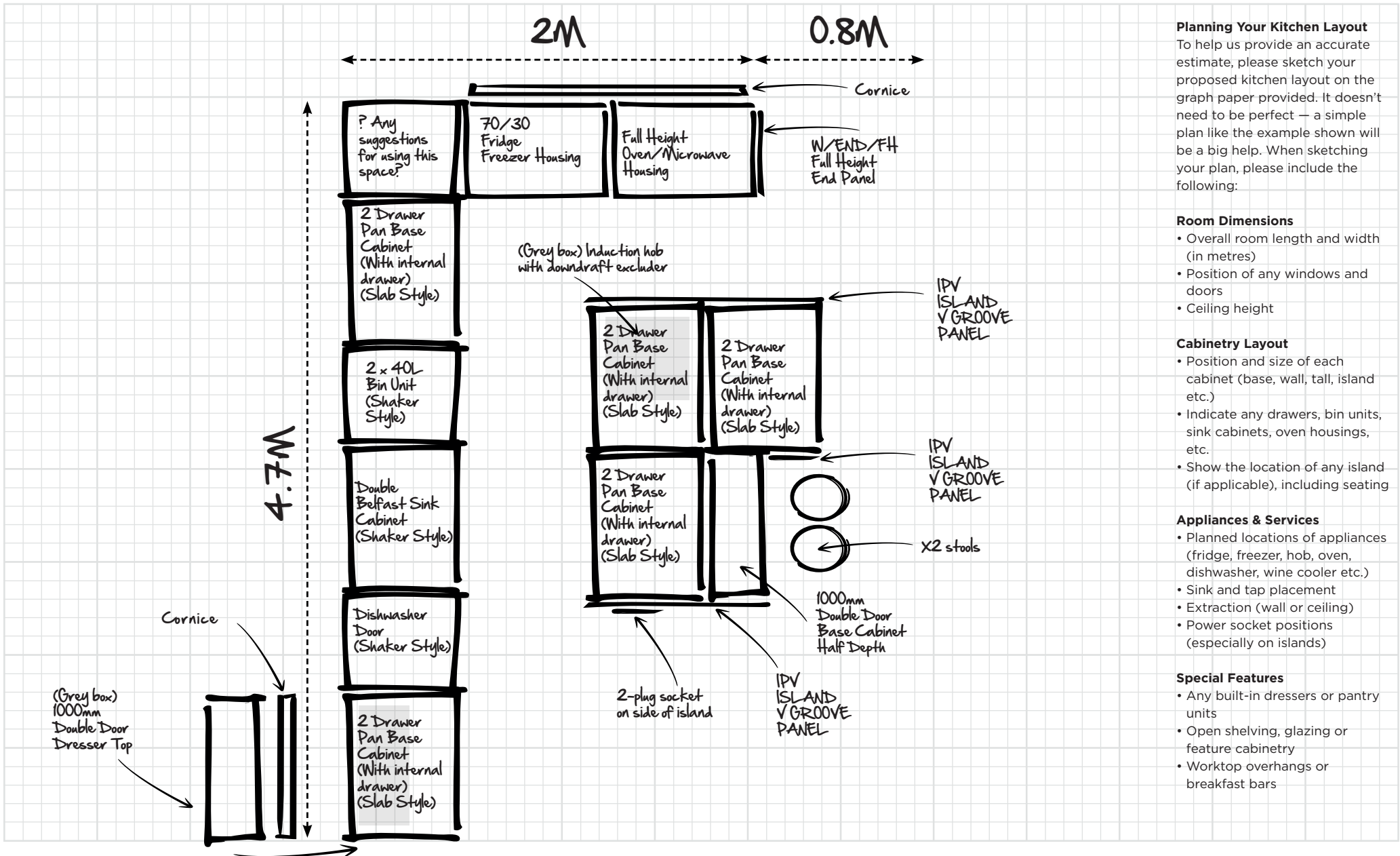


Example... your kitchen plan:



Planning Your Kitchen Layout
 To help us provide an accurate estimate, please sketch your proposed kitchen layout on the graph paper provided. It doesn't need to be perfect – a simple plan like the example shown will be a big help. When sketching your plan, please include the following:

- Room Dimensions**
- Overall room length and width (in metres)
 - Position of any windows and doors
 - Ceiling height

- Cabinetry Layout**
- Position and size of each cabinet (base, wall, tall, island etc.)
 - Indicate any drawers, bin units, sink cabinets, oven housings, etc.
 - Show the location of any island (if applicable), including seating

- Appliances & Services**
- Planned locations of appliances (fridge, freezer, hob, oven, dishwasher, wine cooler etc.)
 - Sink and tap placement
 - Extraction (wall or ceiling)
 - Power socket positions (especially on islands)

- Special Features**
- Any built-in dressers or pantry units
 - Open shelving, glazing or feature cabinetry
 - Worktop overhangs or breakfast bars
